

## WALKER CADDY

### Supplies & Cutting:

- 16" x 43" focal fabric  
16" x 43" lining (Polyester is a good choice as well)
- Batting – 16" x 43"
- Velcro: 2 - 7" pieces                      Sub cut to 3 1/2" (making 4 in total)

### Sew:

- Put right sides of focal fabric and lining together.
- Place the batting under the two layers of fabric and sew 1/4" or 1/2" around the rectangle, leaving 3" - 4" opening for turning.
- Clip corners and turn right side out.
- Top stitch 1/8" or 1/4" around the whole rectangle.
- Use free motion quilting or sew straight lines to keep the sandwich intact.

Mark the centre of the rectangle (approx. 21") and stitch across the width.

### Velcro:

- On the **FOCAL FABRIC** – measure 5 1/2" down from the stitched centre line and 1 1/2" from the edge (do this on all four sides). Sew Velcro loops on one side and hooks on the other side of centre line. **Do not use fusible Velcro – they gum up your needle.**

### Placement of Pockets:

- Open up the rectangle with lining on top. To make the pockets, fold up each end approx. 8" or 8 1/2".
- Sew the sides of pockets - 1/8" or 1/4". At corners of pockets (on each four sides) sew a small triangle for extra strength.
- When sewing the centre line of pockets, back tack at top for extra strength.
- Pockets: 2 on each side. You may vary the width of each pocket.
