

## seymour Quilters' Guild Block of the Month - February 2026

### Tulip Block (Version 2)

#### Fabric Requirements:

Colour 1 (white background):

Cut (4) 3" squares for HSTs

Cut (4) 2½" x 2½" squares

Cut (4) 2½" x 4½"

Colour 2 (Pink):

Cut (5) 2½" x 2½"

Colour 3 (Purple):

Cut (4) 3" squares for HSTs



#### Step 1:

Take your 3" squares of the white and green fabrics to make your HSTs. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the white background squares and place right sides together on top of the green squares. Sew on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart. Press towards the darker fabric. Trim to 2½" x 2½". There is very little to trim off. You will have 8 HSTs.

#### Step 2:

Next make the 4 corner units. Take one 2½" x 2½" white, one 2½" x 2½" Colour 2 (flower), and two of your HSTs. Refer to picture above and sew them as pictured. Repeat making a total of 4 corner units. Each corner unit should measure approximately 4½" x 4½".

#### Step 3:

You will now layout all the units as shown in the block pictured above like a nine patch. See photograph for colour placement.

Sew the three horizontal rows together. Press the seams for the top and bottom rows to the outsides, and the middle row towards the centre. Join the rows together. Your block should measure 10½" x 10½" unfinished.
